Photography Workshop

Workshop Description

In this workshop, students will develop essential photography skills while exploring their creativity in one of six tracks: Portraiture, Landscape, Journalism, Cyanotype, Collage, or Still Life/Product. Each session will help students experiment with different techniques, refine their work, and create a final project that reflects their personal style and interests.

Workshop Structure:

- Workshop 1: Introduction & Exploration (1 hour)
- Workshop 2: Storytelling & Experimentation (1 hour)
- Workshop 3: Final Presentation & Reflection (1 hour)

Tracts:

- 1. Portraiture
- 2. Landscape
- 3. **Journalism**
- 4. Cyanotype
- 5. Collage
- 6. Still Life/Product

Workshop 1: Introduction & Exploration

Goal: Teach photography basics, introduce each tract, and have students start experimenting within their chosen track.

• Lesson:

- Visual Fundamentals
 - Composition
 - Lighting (In/ Outdoor)
 - Perspective
 - Editing

Concept/ Storytelling

- Mood boarding
- "Stealing like an artist"/ Experimentation
- Visual and Storytelling Elements
 - Frame
 - Pose
 - Color
 - Lighting
 - Probs
 - Environment
- Cover Tracts
- Shoot
- Activity: Students take 5-10 experimental shots or work on their cyanotype/collage.
- Assignment "Final Project":
 - Make a moodboard or keyword list or Find 2-3 Photographers that you like.
 - Capture and choose 2-3 pieces to refine for next session and write a sentence on the theme or story behind each piece.
 - o Bring anything related to your project that you might think you need for next time.

Workshop 2: Storytelling & Experimentation

Goal: Refine technique and focus on developing a clear story or message through their work.

- Activity: Students review and take new photos or refine their cyanotypes/collages using experimental techniques.
- Assignment: Continue shooting for the "Final Project" and select the final 1-3 pieces
 they want to showcase and prepare to discuss their creative process in the final
 workshop.

Workshop 3: Final Presentation & Reflection

Goal: Students present their final work and explain the choices they made in developing their photos, cyanotypes, or collages.

Activity:

- Students finalize their work.
- o **Portraiture**: Present 3 portrait shots that tell a story.
- Landscape: Show how lighting or framing transformed a scene.
- Journalism: Present a mini-photo essay.
- **Cyanotype**: Display a final cyanotype print, explaining object and light choices.
- Collage: Present a finished collage that blends different images into a cohesive theme.
- Still Life/Product: Show 3 well-arranged still life shots with an emphasis on composition.
- Presentation: Each student shares their "Final Project," explaining their creative process and the story they aimed to tell. The class has conversation regarding work.
